Ages 3–4
10:00–11:30 a.m.

Nurture a child's creativity! Young children explore art concepts by working with paint, collage and clay. Visits to the galleries contain age-appropriate activities that allow students to see and talk about art as a group. Students should feel comfortable attending class without a parent or guardian.

ANCIENT ART DETECTIVES

Ages 5–6

1:30–3:30 p.m.

It's time to play detective! Discover the who, what, when, where and how of art from long ago as you learn about line, shape, color, texture and more. Visit the galleries of ancient art from Egypt, Greece, Rome and China and the exhibition *Queen Nefertari: Eternal Egypt*. Create your own paintings, your own sculptures and more inspired by what you see.

TIME TRAVELERS FROM ANCIENT EGYPT

Ages 6–8
10:00 a.m.–Noon OR
1:30–3:30 p.m.

Imagine you had lived in ancient Egypt and magically transported to 2020 in a time machine! Create an avatar, a symbolic character who represents you, as you tell the amazing story of your journey. Design a sculpture of your time travel vehicle, explore writing in hieroglyphs and make artwork inspired by life in ancient Egypt. Visit the featured exhibition *Queen Nefertari: Eternal Egypt* as well as the galleries of ancient Egyptian art to guide your creativity.

LET'S DRAW!

Ages 8–12
1:30–3:30 p.m.

Draw weekly in the galleries, working with line, shape, texture, contour, shading and composition. Assorted drawing media, such as graphite, charcoal, oil pastels and more will be explored. You will also experiment a bit with non-traditional drawing tools and media.

CARTOONING: OCEANS OF FUNNY!

Ages 9–14

Can an anchovy carry a tuna? Yes! Come imagine and draw funny ocean creatures doing funny things! Begin by drawing circles, squares and triangles and add to them eyes, fins, shells and bubbles! Next draw your ocean cartoon characters in brief funny stories! Maybe create a one-octopus rock band or halibuts having a pillow fight! Perhaps draw turtles in tutus dancing ballet! Learn to draw your funny ocean ideas and characters in gag cartoons, comic strips and comic books.

CLAY: EXTRAORDINARY EGYPT

10:00 a.m.–Noon (Ages 9–13)
1:30–3:30 p.m. (Ages 7–9)

Investigate how the ancient Egyptians lived and prepared for the afterlife. Enter an incredible world of elaborate tombs, pharaohs, queens, gods, goddesses and much more. Learn various hand-building techniques for creating in clay and assorted surface treatments with glaze. Class will visit the featured exhibition *Queen Nefertari: Eternal Egypt* and the galleries of Egyptian art to gain inspiration!

TOMB EXPLORERS

10:00 a.m.–Noon (Ages 7–9)
1:30–3:30 p.m. (Ages 9–13)

The ancient Egyptians created glorious tombs, stocked with objects for use in the afterlife. Learn about the art made for tombs as you explore the featured exhibition *Queen Nefertari: Eternal Egypt* and create drawings, paintings and sculpture. You will even create your own three-dimensional model of an Egyptian tomb!
